Job Opportunities

Construction Crew Leader

For one year, get paid to build sustainable solutions in a community, gain valuable hands-on experience and prepare for your future. This full-time AmeriCorps service position offers a great opportunity to make an impact in the lives of others while building your own knowledge and skillset.

AmeriCorps National members serve the community in direct service and capacity building activities.

What will you do?

The construction crew leader plays an integral part in building and repairing homes. Lead groups of skills and unskilled volunteers and homeowner families in construction activities while maintaining a safe, efficient work environment, thus, developing and enhancing your volunteer management and construction skills.

- Typically serve Tuesday Saturday on the build site roughly 6am-2pm.
- Assist with all aspects of hands-on construction tasks including, but not limited to, demolition, site prep, framing, insulation, drywall, flooring, roofing, finish carpentry and landscaping.
- Projects may include new construction, rehabilitation, critical home repair and weatherization
 projects as well as assist in our new workforce development center, "The CHUCK" building
 prefabricated walls and other tasks.
- Lead and work alongside small groups of volunteers and facilitate safe and positive experiences for everyone working on site.
- Maintain site safety by adhering to Habitat construction safety policies, modeling best practices and guidelines, volunteer education and site monitoring.

This position will focus on home construction, home repair and neighborhood revitalization aspects of Habitat affiliate operations.

Where will you serve?

- Habitat for Humanity Tucson
- Unique projects: Habitat Tucson is engaged in many projects and is set up for many years of future projects. We not only build residential 2–5-bedroom homes, but we also do critical home repair for current homeowners, provide A Brush with Kindness, which is from the curb back, providing things such as painting, yard work, building wheelchair ramps, installing gutters for those aging in place or those who are Veterans. We have many future projects that will help more than 70 families in the near future, and our most exciting project is our CHUCK Center which is also a workforce Development Center where we can invite students, volunteers, educators to learn about construction trades. We are building ADU's inside the Center as well as prefabricated walls that will go onto our future homes.

Benefits of AmeriCorps service

- Living allowance of \$17,600 for approximately 10 ½ months of service (roughly a little over \$700 per paycheck depending on taxes).
- Segal Education Award of \$6,895, upon successful completion of service (use this for school, student loans, or school supplies).
- Forbearance for most federally-guaranteed student loans.
- Health care benefits and enrollment in Employee Assistance Plan.
- Personal and medical leave approximately 10 days total.
- Personal and professional development opportunities.
- Child care benefits, if you qualify.
- Worker's compensation insurance.

Supplemental Benefits

- Mileage reimbursement if using your own vehicle
- Grocery gift card \$75 per month

Minimum Requirements

Applicants must be a U.S. citizen, national or lawful permanent resident at least 18 or older and have a high school diploma or GED.


